Complimentary Collections	Preston Medical Library/UT Medical Center. Nursing & Biological Sciences Collections at Hodges Library. Electronic journal & physical collections including: SpringerLink, Science Direct & BioOne; Wiley, STAT!Ref, Current Protocols. Access via catalog or the list at http://www.lib.utk.edu/databases/	
Scan On Demand	Library provides an electronic copy of chapters & articles for free upon request. (One chapter per book.) Great for vet med because a large % of the veterinary collection is unavailable electronically compared to human biomedicine.	
Interlibrary Loan	Free electronic & physical delivery of materials <i>not</i> in UT collections.
