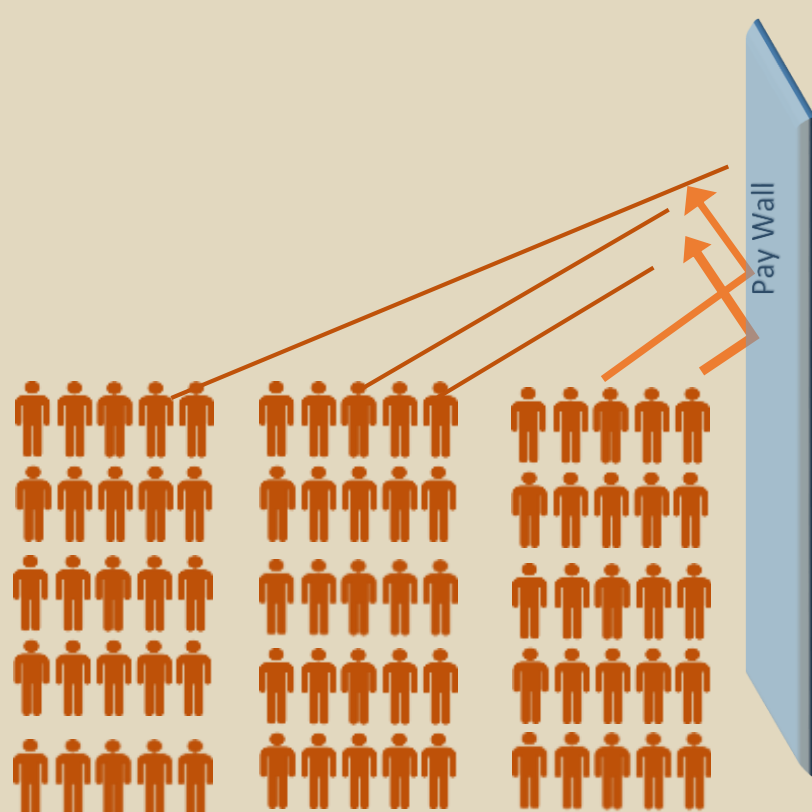
In 2013 there were...

download or view the research

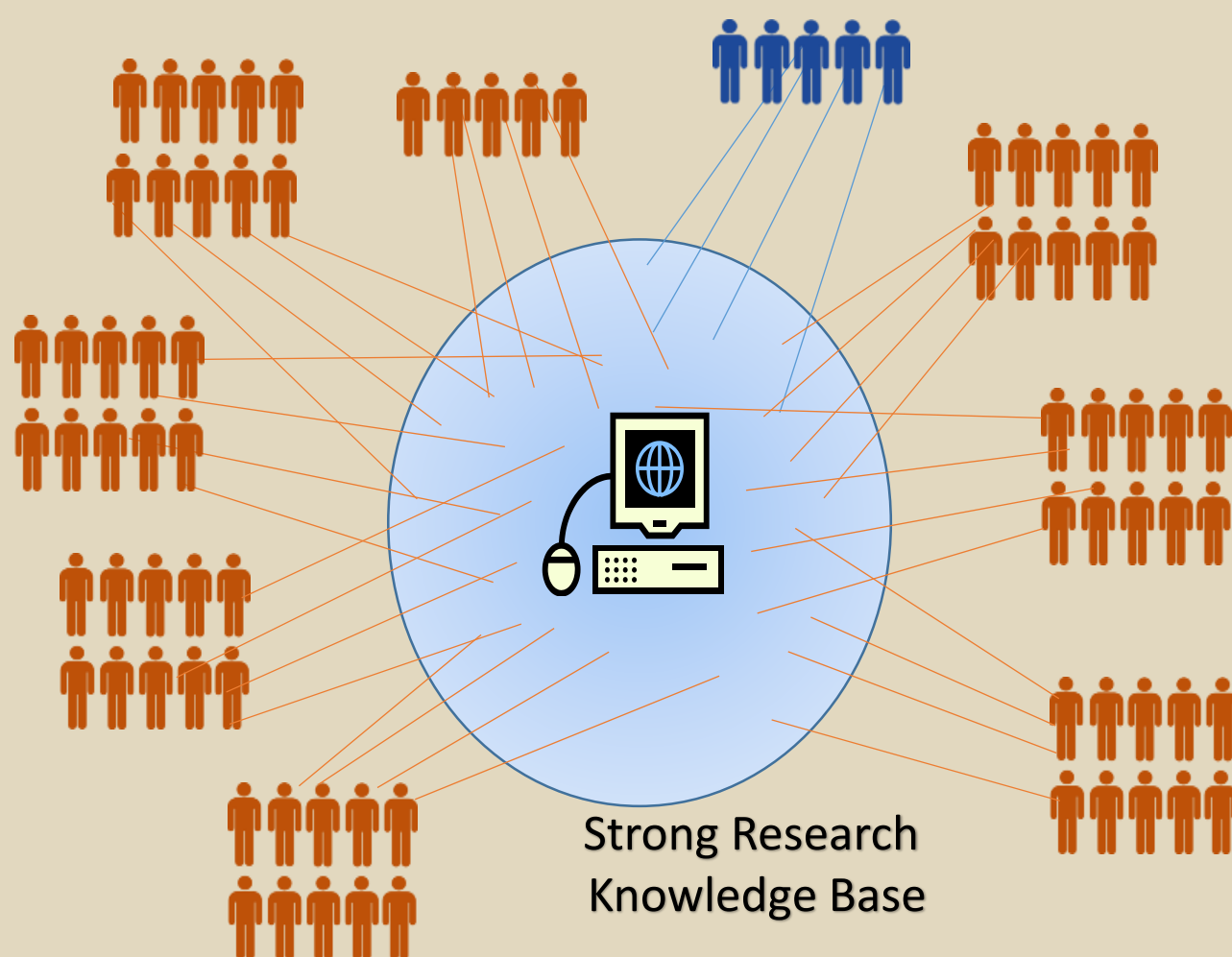


Weak Research

You can **negotiate** open access rights by attaching a simple author's addendum to your publication contracts, you can **publish in open access journals**, or **just stay in the loop** about new open access initiatives.
